We have been asking for this information for over a year to allow people plenty of time to respond. We realize that everyone is extremely busy and that this request is not at the top of your list of things to do. However, we are trying to save funds for the cats and do not want to send newsletters to those who are not interested in receiving it. Therefore, please respond. We do not want to eliminate people from the list who are truly interested in cats and our efforts to help them. If you want to continue receiving the mailed copy that is certainly fine, but we simply need to know. Please respond. We appreciate your help.

## Guidelines for Planning for Your Pet's Care

Have you ever thought about what would happen to your pet, if you were unable to care for him or her? Too many never think about this or assume that a friend or relative will care for the pet if they cannot. These assumptions can result in the pet being taken to a shelter and put to death or dumped on the street to fend for itself and possibly die. To prevent this from happening to your pet, plan ahead. (1)You should always arrange with someone you know well to take your pet and provide "forever" care for it. If you do not have a friend or relative who can provide this care, make arrangements with a local "no-kill" facility to take your pet when the
need arises. (2)You should always provide written instructions on the care and needs of your pet to the designated caregiver. This is the only way that your pet's caregiver will know your wishes and the pet's requirements. Of course, provide this information to your lawyer for safe keeping. If your pet will go to a rescue, they will also need this information. If you have multiple pets, note if they should stay together or could be separated. (3)You should set funding aside for the continued care of your pet whether the pet is going to a friend or a rescue. Your lawyer, estate planner, financial planner, or insurance company can assist you on the proper, legal, safe way to setup this fund. (4) You need to make your plans known to everyone and have instructions visible in your house. Documentation is the best way to assure that your wishes are followed and your pets are safe and properly cared for the rest of their lives. Be sure to note the number of pets in your home, the location of their supplies, the name of your pet sitter if you have one, your veterinarian's name, phone number and location, and the name and phone number of your pet's designated caregiver. Please do not leave all of this to chance. No one wants to think of being incapacitated or dying, but you must plan for your pet's future if something happens to you. You do not want your pet to be left helpless and unwanted wandering the streets or being put to death because you did not plan for his future.

## Need for Identification on Your Pet

We would like to remind you about the need for identification on your pet at all times. Many people think that if their cat is always indoors or has a microchip, there is no need for a collar and identification tag. This is not true! Too often, cats accidentally slip out and are lost. If your home is burglarized or a fire breaks out, your pet may also get out and be lost. They are usually very afraid of the noise and activity outside and will hide. Even if they hear or see their owner, they are too afraid to go to them. People believe that if their cat is microchipped, there is no need for identification. They think that if their cat is taken to a shelter, it will automatically be scanned for a chip. Unfortunately, there is at least one organization is this area that does not
always scan for a microchip. Your cat could be "put down" even though it has a microchip. If the cat is wearing a collar and tag, there is no chance that it will not be seen. Of course, the collar should not be loose as the cat can get caught on something and choked. For a cat, there should be room for only one finger under the buckle, whereas, there should be room for two fingers under the buckle for a dog. You do not want to put your cat at risk of being lost without identification. No one plans on their cat being lost, but it happens too often. Your cat cannot tell someone who he belongs to, he has to depend on you to have him identified. For his protection and safety, and your sanity, please have identification on you cat or dog. If someone finds the cat or dog with identification, your pet can be back to you immediately. Many people who have found a cat, call us for help. We always suggest that they have the cat scanned for a chip before trying to find a home for it. It may very well be someone's beloved pet who has become lost. Many people do not even think about having the cat scanned for a chip. Identification can be the only chance your pet has of being returned to you.

## Christmas Wish List

The first request on the cats' wish list was for homes of their own. Although, a few of the cats found new, loving homes over the holidays, there are still so many great cats that need homes. We are housing over four hundred and fifty cats. As we are a no-kill, some are not adoptable for medical or personality reasons. However, the majority would make loving pets for the right person or family. They are waiting for that special someone to take them home and love them for the rest of their lives. If you need or want a new friend, please call us to set up an appointment.

The second request was for more volunteers to care for the cats. Four people answered this request and have made the cats very happy. They enjoy having more people to care for them and pet them. The volunteers scoop litter boxes, feed and water, clean housing areas, and, of course, pet and care for the cats. The rewards are amazing - purrs, rubs, kneading, head bumps, kisses, and lap sitting. They are so appreciative of everyone who
cares for them and visits them. Would you like to help the cats and yourself by volunteering at The Tenth Life? Please call us to setup a time.

The donations to the general operating fund were unbelievable. Our supporters donated over thirty thousand dollars during this holiday season to the general operating fund. These funds are used for the day-to-day operations of The Tenth Life. With your generous donations we can continue to help homeless, unwanted cats that would otherwise not have a chance for a "tenth life." There are so many cats that need help, and with your donations, we can help even more.

As always, many, many supplies were donated to help the cats. These donations are so helpful and save us so much. We really appreciate your donations.

Ten of the cats got their wish for sponsors this holiday. We welcome the new sponsors and are grateful for their support. The new sponsor cats are so happy and constantly tell their friends about having a special person who supports them. There are still many of the cats who do not have sponsors but would love to have one and have a new friend to visit them. If you would like to sponsor, please tell us, and we can choose a cat for you or you can visit The Tenth Life to select one. It is a mere ten dollar per month donation to sponsor a cat. ## Annual Plant Sale

It is time to begin thinking about spring and your plant needs. The order blank for the annual plant sale is included in this newsletter. The selection has changed slightly, and there are a few changes in the prices necessitated by price increases from Furst, the supplier of all of the plants. We have maintained as many prices as possible at last year's levels. We have a huge selection of annual bedding plants, hanging baskets, mixed flowering pots, patio pots, vegetables, herbs, and perennials. Please see the order blank for the entire selection and prices. The plants will be of the highest quality and beautiful. You will not be disappointed with any of these plants. If there is a plant that you would like to have but do not see it on the order blank, please note it on the order blank. If Furst has it, we can get it for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst and return your call with the availability and price. Please remember to tell your friends, neighbors, co-workers, and family about our plant sale. If you need more order blanks, call us, and we will be glad to send them to you or you can download the order blank from our web site. The more plants that we sell, the more profits for the cats. Last year we sold about twenty-six thousand dollars of plants with nearly half of that amount being profit. This is one of our biggest fund raisers, and it has grown every year. We understand that it is early to think about plant needs, but we would like to have your orders, with payment, by March $10{ }^{\text {th }}$. Furst asks for the majority of our order by the middle of March to accommodate their ordering and growing requirements. By placing our order by mid March, we receive an earlyorder discount that allows us to keep our prices lower. We must have our complete, final order to them a few weeks before the delivery date. If you cannot meet the due date for any reason, please send your order blank as soon as you can, and we will have your plants available for you. Even if you cannot send your order until almost the pick-up date, still send your order, and we will take your order from the extras that we purchase.

As always, we will have two to three thousand dollars of extras available for your shopping convenience. We try to have extras of everything, but we cannot guarantee to have everything that you want; therefore pre-ordering
is your best option to assure that we have all the plants that you want. Therefore, please send your orders by the due date, but if it is not possible, send your orders to us so we can accommodate your desires and help the cats. Remember, it is never too late to send your order, but it really helps us to get your orders in a timely manner. Whenever, we receive your order we will fulfill your needs. Please help us with this fund raiser and allow us to help the needy cats of the community.

The plants will be available for pickup beginning at $4: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ on May $8^{\text {th }}$. This is the week before Mother's Day. These plants and arrangements make excellent gifts for everyone on your Mother's Day gift list. You will have your gifts already bought, and the receivers will be thrilled with your thoughtfulness. At the same time you are helping the cats raise funds for their care. The hours for pickup are $\mathbf{4 : 3 0 - 7 : 3 0 p m}$ weeknights, 10:30am-5:00pm on Saturday and 12:305:00pm on Sunday. Please make special note of these times and do not come at any other time as the gate could be closed or no one would be available to help you find your order. We cannot have people coming for their orders and searching through the orders for the one that they think is theirs. Orders can be messed-up so easily this way, and then our customers are unhappy with us. We try so hard to have everyone's order filled correctly, and in a convenient order that we can locate and recheck your order when you pick it up. By the time the orders are ready for our customers, they have been filled and checked twice to try to be sure that they are correct. If customers come when there is no help, they may take part or all of an order that looks like theirs, but is not theirs and ruin our system and mess up someone else's order. Please adhere to our hours. If you simply cannot come during our hours of operation, please call us at (937) 376-5550, and we will make arrangements with you to accommodate your schedule. One more point, if you find an error in your order, please call us or bring your order back, and we will certainly correct our error. We try so hard to be sure that every order is correct, but we are human and with nearly three hundred orders, errors do occur. Please let us correct any problem so that you are one hundred percent satisfied with your plants. We will be waiting for your orders. If you have any questions about the plant sale, please call (937) 376-5550
during our hours of operation. If we do have the answer, we will check with Furst and return your call with the needed information.

## Easter Pie Sale

We are again offering Pie Peddler pies from Mehaffies for your Easter dinner needs. The order blank for the Easter pie sale is also included in this newsletter. They are absolutely delicious. They are like homemade but without the work, and you can buy several to offer your guests a wonderful selection of flavors. The Thanksgiving pie sale was another successful one. We sold one hundred and thirty-one pies for a profit of four hundred and eighty-seven dollars. We thank Mehaffies Pie Peddler for making the sale possible and profitable. Thanks to everyone who purchased pies.

The greenery and plant sale was also successful and profitable for the cats. All of the plants and greenery were sold at a profit of twelve hundred and forty-one dollars. They were all beautiful and added such a gorgeous, festive touch to the holidays for everyone who purchased the plants or greenery. We plan to offer the greenery and plants next year. Thanks to everyone who purchased these holiday items and to the volunteers who worked these sales.

We held our first bazaar on November $26^{\text {th }}$ and continued selling our merchandise through the second sale on December $17^{\text {th }}$. The second sale coincided with the Christmas bake sale. The cats earned over forty-two hundred dollars in profits from the bazaars and the bake sale. This was a little less than the sales last year. Thank you to everyone who made purchases and donations to these sales. For the bake sale, we had sixty-one varieties
of cookies, candies, breads, cakes, etc. The selection was unbelievable. A huge thank you to everyone who donated baked goods. All of the bake sale items were delicious. We received so many compliments on the baked goods. Some people came back more than once for more baked goods.

Thanks to all our pie purchasers. We will be offering the pies again for Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas this year. We thank the Pie Peddler for making this sale possible by providing their delicious pies.

Although we thought that we would not be able to have pictures with Santa this year, we were able with the help of Pets Supplies Plus, to have sessions in their two stores. On December $10^{\text {th }}, 11^{\text {th }}, 17^{\text {th }}$, and $18^{\text {th }}$, we had pictures with Santa at the Kettering store and the Centerville store. We thank their managers and employees for helping us with these picture-taking sessions. We thank our volunteers who were Santa and his helpers for making these weekends profitable for the cats. We earned seven hundred and seventy-one dollars for the cats. We earned nearly double that amount last year, but we were at four Complete Pet Mart stores for two weekends. This was a last-minute effort this year to do the pictures at Pet Supplies Plus as we had to have the permission of their headquarters. We worked quickly, but did not have much time for advertising the event. To make this much, under those circumstances, was doing very well. Unfortunately, we had trouble with one of our printers that caused some delays, but our volunteers worked through it. We thank everyone who participated. We plan to work with them again next year to do pictures with Santa.

The sale of the 2011 original-design Christmas card was the best yet. We sold nearly all one thousand of the cards that we had printed. Everyone loved the design and thought it was extremely creative. We thank our volunteer, Abby Voris, for her design. Unfortunately, she has moved to Texas, and we have lost a dedicated volunteer. We miss you Abby.

With all of these fund raisers at the end of the year, we were all very busy, but the sales were extremely helpful in raising funds for the care of the cats. Thanks to everyone who helped in any way to make these fund raisers successful.

## Current Fund Raisers

We still have a few of the 2012 Entertainment books available. They sell for thirty dollars and are loaded with money-saving coupons for almost every type of purchase that you may make. The cats receive about seven dollars from every book sold. The books are no longer available at the businesses except for Dayton South Veterinary Clinic on Wilmington Avenue in Kettering. Of course, they are still available at The Tenth Life. We can still ship one to you for an additional three dollars for shipping.

The Tenth Life apparel including t-shirts (short and long sleeve) and sweatshirts, are always available in a variety of colors. The $t$-shirts are fifteen dollars for shortsleeve ones and twenty dollars for the long-sleeve variety. Sweatshirts sell for twenty-five dollars. The tote bags are twenty-five dollars and are gray. All have The Tenth Life logo embroidered on the front of the item. Any can be shipped to you for two dollars for shipping for the $t$-shirts or three dollars for the sweatshirts and tote bags.

We also always have the great selection of catnip toys which include crocheted balls and fish, fabric pillows and fish, catnip mats and catnip furry beds. The balls and pillows are two dollars, the fish are three dollars, and the catnip mats and beds are ten dollars. They come in a variety of colors filled with catnip for your cat's pleasure. Shipping depends on number of toys ordered but is usually a couple of dollars. The cats love these toys because they are filled with fresh catnip, not catnip that was picked years ago. Your cats will be thrilled with these toys.

Cat trees and furniture are available from The Tenth Life all year. With our having a local supplier for the cat trees, we are able to offer a nice variety of the furniture.

We sell the cat trees/furniture for only thirty dollars over our cost. With the local supplier, there is no transportation charge so you save even more. We have a booklet of trees available and hope to have it on our website in the near future. Your cats will love these trees because they are well-built and sturdy. They will not topple over if your cat rushes to the top of the tree. If you have been thinking about a tree for your cat, this is the best price you will find for this quality of tree, and your cat will be very happy.

The Tenth Life cookbooks are also available for twelve dollars with an additional charge of three dollars if you would like the cookbook shipped to you. There are three hundred and fifty recipes for delicious dishes that you can prepare. You profit with these yummy recipes, and the cats profit from your purchase. The cookbooks make excellent gifts for your friends who love to cook or bake. You will be thrilled with the cookbook.

If you shop at Kroger and have not purchased one of our cards, we would love for you get a card from The Tenth Life. You purchase a card from The Tenth Life with twenty-five, fifty or one hundred dollars loaded on it, use it until the funds are all used, then reload the card with additional funds, and the cats receive four percent of the amount you load for their care. With all of the cards we have sold, the cats receive about four to five hundred dollars per month. This is an easy fund raiser for The Tenth Life and costs you nothing to help the cats. You simply purchase your groceries using the gift card, and the cats benefit.

## Reminders

Your support of our requests for aluminum, pennies, Fresh Step Paw Points, ink cartridges, and coupons has been overwhelming. Please continue saving these items for The Tenth Life. The aluminum can be any type of aluminum from drink and pet food cans to spouting and siding. (A magnet will not stick to aluminum, but will to other metals.) The pennies can be wrapped or not wrapped. The Fresh Step Paw Points code can be found on the bag or box or in the pail of litter. The code is usually twelve characters and is not the lot number. Simply cut off the top layer of the bag with the code and send it to us. Be sure to cut out the entire code. It does not always exactly coincide with the spacing on the outside of the bag. Please save any ink cartridges for us to recycle and earn rewards. We also appreciate your saving coupons for cat food, Fresh Step litter, paper towels, facial tissue, and toilet paper. All of these can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation. If you cannot transport the aluminum, we can pick-up. The Paw Points, ink cartridges, and coupons can be sent to the post office box.
