## Heart-Warming Story

The story for this newsletter concerns two cats who were adopted recently. The first is Lyndsey who is about five months old and her best friend, Otto, who is about nine months old. Lyndsey arrived with a femeral neck fracture at the age of ten weeks. Otto, unfortunately had suffered more severe injuries. He had hidden in the engine of a car to avoid a heavy rain storm. When the owner of the car started the engine, Otto was badly injured from the fan blade. He lost one entire rear leg, his tail and part of the other rear leg. Of course, he had a great deal of infection from his injuries, but has completely recovered and moves faster than anyone can imagine. He and Lyndsey have become best friends and love to wrestle and chase. Of course with Lyndsey being a little girl, she cries like he is hurting her when they wrestle, even though she started the tussle. A typical little girl kitty. They have been adopted by a dear friend of The Tenth Life and her husband. She is the nice lady who bakes so many of the baked goods for our bake sales. They recently lost one of their precious cats to mouth cancer. When they saw Lyndsey sticking her feet out from under the door of her room, they had to see her, and immediately fell in love. After seeing her friend, they decided to take both and give them a loving home. They are very lucky babies, especially Otto with his handicaps that are not handicaps for him. He has completely adjusted to his life and does not feel that he has any problems. They chase up and down the hallway in their new home and Otto has no trouble keeping up with Lyndsey. We wish them years of happiness and love.

## Helpful Hint

Our helpful hint for this newsletter is to always use a carrier when taking your cat somewhere. Too many people think that they can carry their cat in their arms
with no consequences. Unfortunately, if the cat is afraid or gets spooked, the cat could jump out of their arms with no difficulty. They could easily scratch them very badly with their claws when they try to escape their grasp. People believe that even if the cat jumps out of their arms, the cat will come back to them when they call it. Normally this is not the case. The cat is so scared by the new surroundings that it thinks it has never seen you before and will run as fast as it can to find a safe place to hide. This happens too often when people take their cat to the veterinarian. Most clinics are on busy roads with lots of noise which frightens the cat. In addition, the cat has just experienced a car ride which most cats do not enjoy, and it frightened them. The use of a carrier is important for the car ride so that the cat does not get under your feet at the pedals or climb all over you distracting you from your driving. Another important reason to always have your cat in a carrier in the car is in case you have an accident. If the cat is loose in the car and there is an accident, the cat can run away and never be found. You will never know what happened to your cat and whether he is dead or alive, trying to survive on the streets. Please, always put your cat in a carrier before leaving your house and never take him out until you are inside at your destination. Using a carrier is safer for you and your cat and can save both of you from suffering.

Two new volunteers have joined to help with the care of the cats. We welcome them and truly appreciate their interest in volunteering and helping the cats to feel loved. The volunteers scoop litter boxes, feed and water the cats and clean their rooms. Each volunteer has a specific area to clean and maintain. Of course, the best part is the love and attention the cats give you while you are trying to clean. Some help you scoop litter boxes, play in the flow of water when you are trying to fill bowls, or eat out of the bowls while you are trying to add food. They are such helpers. They do add to the fun of the work. It is very rewarding to work with the cats and see them develop into loving cats as they become accustomed to their new surroundings. Please consider offering your assistance to their care.

Donations to the general operating fund exceeded our expectations. Supporters of The Tenth Life donated slightly over thirty-five thousand one hundred dollars during the holiday season. We appreciate your generosity and kindness toward the cats. These donations will greatly help with the operation of The Tenth Life and the associated expenses. Please remember all donations are tax deductible. All letters of acknowledgement have been sent. If we missed your letter, please alert us so that we can correct the oversight.

*Available at Lowe's for $\$ 8.98$ for a fifty-foot roll. A volunteer is replacing the sisal on the cat trees in all of the rooms, and this would help with the expense. Repairing the existing trees is less expensive than replacing them.

## Annual Plant Sale

It is time to begin thinking about spring and your plant needs. The order blank for the annual plant sale is included in this newsletter. The selection has changed slightly, and there are a few changes in the prices necessitated by price increases from Furst, the supplier of all of the plants. We have maintained as many prices as possible at last year's levels. We have a huge selection of annual bedding plants, hanging baskets, mixed flowering pots, patio pots, vegetables, herbs, and perennials. Please see the order blank for the entire selection and prices. The plants will be of the highest quality and beautiful. You will not be disappointed with any of these plants. If there is a plant that you would like to have but do not see it on the order blank, please note it on the order blank. If Furst has it, we can get it for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst and return your call with the availability and price. Please remember to tell your friends, neighbors, co-workers, and family about our plant sale. If you need more order blanks, call us, and we will be glad to send them to you or you can download the order blank from the web site. The more plants that we sell, the more profits for the cats. Last year we sold about twenty-six thousand dollars of plants with nearly half of that amount being profit. This is one of our biggest fund raisers, and it has grown every year. We understand that it is early to think about plant needs, but we would like to have your orders, with payment, by March $15^{\text {th }}$. Furst asks for the majority of our order by the middle of March to accommodate their order and growing requirements. By placing our order by mid March, we receive an earlyorder discount that allows us to keep our prices lower. We must have our complete, final order to them a few weeks before the delivery date. If you cannot meet the due date for any reason, please send your order blank as soon as you can, and we will have your plants available for you. Even if you cannot send your order until almost the pick-up date, still send your order, and we will take your order from the extras that we purchase.

As always, we will have two to three thousand dollars of extras available for your shopping convenience. We try to have extras of everything, but we cannot guarantee to have everything that you want; therefore pre-ordering
is your best option to assure that we have all the plants that you want. Therefore, please send your orders by the due date, but if it is not possible, send your orders to us so we can accommodate your desires and help the cats. Remember, it is never too late to send your order, but it really helps us to get your orders in a timely manner. Whenever, we receive your order we will fulfill your needs. Please help us with this fund raiser and allow us to help the needy cats of the community.

The plants will be available for pickup beginning at $4: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ on May $6^{\text {th }}$. This is the week before Mother's Day. These plants and arrangements make excellent gifts for everyone on your Mother's Day gift list. You will have your gifts already bought, and the receivers will be thrilled with your thoughtfulness. At the same time you are helping the cats raise funds for their care. The hours for pickup are 4:30-7:30pm weeknights, 10:30am5:00pm on Saturday and 12:30-5:00pm on Sunday. Please make a special note of these times and do not come at any other time as the gate could be closed or no one would be available to help you find your order. We cannot have people coming for their orders and searching through the orders for the one that they think is theirs. Orders can be confused so easily this way, and then our customers are unhappy with us. We try so hard to have everyone's order filled correctly, and in a convenient order that we can locate and recheck your order when you pick it up. By the time that the orders are ready for our customers, they have been filled and checked twice to try to be sure that they are correct. If customers come when there is no help, they may take part or all of an order that looks like theirs, but is not, and cause someone else's order to be incorrect. Please adhere to our hours. If you simply cannot come during our hours of operation, please call us at (937) 376-5550, and we will make arrangements with you to accommodate your schedule. One more point, if you find an error in your order, please call us or bring your order back, and we will certainly correct our error. We try so hard to be sure that every order is correct, but we are human and with nearly three hundred orders, errors do occur. Please let us correct any problem so that you are one hundred percent satisfied with your plants. We will be waiting for your orders. If you have any questions about the plant sale, please call (937) 376-5550 during our hours of operation. If we do
not have the answer, we will check with Furst and return your call with the information.

## Easter Pie Sale

We are again offering Pie Peddler pies for your Easter dinner needs. The order blank for the Easter pie sale is also included in this newsletter. The pies are absolutely delicious and are like homemade but without the work, and you can buy several to offer your guests a wonderful selection of flavors. By purchasing our pies, you save yourself hours of baking time and help the cats at the same time. The price of the pies has not changed since the Thanksgiving/Christmas sales. The price is nine dollars per pie (three dollars profit for the cats) and the selection is the same. The specialty pies are ten dollars. Please have your orders, with payment, to us by April $5^{\text {th }}$. If you miss the due date, please call us at (937) 3765550) with your order, and we will accommodate your request from the extras that we order. We will have extras of most flavors, but please pre-order to assure that you get the flavors that you want. The pies will be available for pick-up at The Tenth Life on April 19 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ starting at 10:30am until 5:00pm. See you at pick-up.

## Easter Bake Sale

To further ease your Easter holiday dessert needs, we will also have a bake sale on April 19 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ during the same time period. We will have a huge selection (20-30 varieties) of baked goods for your Easter dinner. 4) Amazon Smile looks and functions just as Amazon normally would, but with the added bonus of $.5 \%$ of all eligible purchases being donated to The Tenth Life.
**It is important to ALWAYS go to smile.amazon.com to make all of your purchases. If you go to the regular Amazon, The Tenth Life will not receive the donation from the purchase and there is not a way to go back and claim it retroactively.**

For people using Google Chrome, there is an add-on called "Smile Always" that can be downloaded and will always redirect you to Amazon Smile, even if you go to the regular Amazon by mistake. There is a similar add-on to Mozilla Firefox called "Amazon Smile Redirect."

This is a great way to help the cats without using any of your funds.

## Past Fund Raisers

We have had several fund raisers since the last newsletter. The first fund raiser was the Thanksgiving pie sale. We sold one hundred and fifteen pies at a profit of over three hundred dollars.

The second fund raiser was the annual plant and greenery sale. We sold all of the plants, wreaths, and roping. The profit was twelve hundred eighty-two dollars. As always the plants and greenery were

During the time between the two bazaars, we sold even more merchandise. Also on December $21^{\text {st }}$, we had our annual holiday bake sale. The profit from these two bazaars and the bake sale was nearly forty-one hundred dollars. We had forty-four varieties of cookies, candies, and cakes. All of the varieties were delicious. We thank all of the bakers who made the bake sale possible. Our shoppers were so generous, and that is why we made such a huge profit for the cats. Thank you for your help and hope that you enjoyed your shopping experience.

In addition on this same day, we had the Christmas pie sale. We sold sixty-five pies at a profit of nearly two hundred dollars. Thanks to everyone who supported the pie sales. As always, the pies were from the Pie Peddler and were absolutely delicious.

The Tenth Life held "Pictures With Santa" at two different businesses this holiday season. On December $14^{\text {th }}$ and $15^{\text {th }}$, we were at Moochie and Company at the Greene taking pet pictures with our Santa and his helper. The crowd was fantastic and the employees of Moochie and Company were so helpful and courteous. We truly thank Moochie and Company for the opportunity to work with them and offer this exciting, fun experience for the customers. For the two days, Santa and his helpers earned five hundred and thirty-five dollars for the cats. Additionally, Moochie and Company had a Christmas tree which featured pictures of The Tenth Life cats (as ornaments) and asked for donations of food or other supplies which helped to support that cat. On December $21^{\text {st }}$ and $22^{\text {nd }}$ we did pictures with Santa at Pet Supplies Plus in Centerville. There was a steady stream of pets and their owners having pictures taken with Santa. The weather was not great on Saturday, but Sunday was much nicer and more people brought their pets in to visit with Santa. Santa and his helpers earned two hundred and seventy dollars for the cats. We thank the Pet Supplies Plus staff for their help and kindness with this event.

The trees that he makes have a large base for stability and are constructed of PVC or sturdy wood covered with carpet, and the posts can be covered with carpet or sisal. Prices vary by height and style. You can choose the color of carpet that you prefer. You and the cats will be thrilled with the furniture.

We still have a few of the 2014 Entertainment books available. The price is twenty-five dollars, but they will save you hundreds of dollars when you use the coupons in the book. Please be sure to cut off the entire code. The pennies can be wrapped or not. We are thrilled to get them either way. Sending coupons for Fresh Step Litter,
cat food, Yesterday's News litter, paper towels, toilet paper, wipes (Lysol or Clorox), and facial tissue save dollars when we shop for supplies. The aluminum can be any type of aluminum from cans (pet food or drink can) to siding and spouting. Canned vegetable cans are steel, not aluminum. A magnet will not stick to aluminum, but will to other metals. Any of these can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation.
